

Hints for the Outdoor Artists:

- ☆ **Art materials**—Bring everything you will need to complete your artwork. (i.e. pencil & sketch pad, paint & canvas, pastels & paper, etc) Don't forget paper towel!
- ☆ **Garbage collection bag**—we want to be sure to leave our work area as clean as when we arrived.
- ☆ **Sun Protection**—Sunscreen / long sleeved shirt / hat / water / umbrella. As the sun moves you may need to be protected. You may also want to protect your palette from the sun interfering with your color selection.
- ☆ **Bug Spray** – Don't wear perfume or cologne, as it attracts bugs. **Bring your bug spray**—This is the Northwoods!!
- ☆ **Camera** – Sometimes a great scene provides an opportunity to take pictures that can be used in the future to complete what was started 'plein air' or to do a new studio piece using the original outdoor piece as a source / study.
- ☆ **Clothes**—Wear dull colors to reduce reflection onto the painting or palette. Dress in layers to accommodate any change in weather.

June 2 Downtown Minocqua

Torpy Park, Bearskin Trail and Main Street all provide very interesting opportunities. This is a great place to open our painting season and lots of opportunities for lunch afterward so we can all catch up on what we learned during the winter! Parking is available in Lot C, next to the post office.

June 9 Chippewa Retreat

Chippewa is a beautiful resort in Manitowish Waters with exquisite frontage overlooking Lake Manitowish. It is located at 13029 Deer Park Rd. Plan to stay for lunch at the White Oak Grill.

June 16 Red Arrow Camp

Over one hundred years ago Red Arrow was a logging camp so it is natural that most of the buildings are of full log construction. The large and beautiful Dining Hall and Rec Hall sit under a canopy of virgin Norway and white pines which were part of the original logging camp back in the mid-1800's. Nearby are the twelve unique authentic log cabins which house 100 campers and were built in 1920. 3980 Day Lake Rd east of Hwy 51 in Woodruff.

June 23 The Boathouse – Minocqua

Previously known at Bosacki's - We are welcome to paint around the building or from the docks. Plan to stay for Lunch!!

June 30 Coon's Franklin Lodge

Located 10 miles north of Minocqua in Arbor Vitae. This beautiful lodge has been owned and operated by the Coon Family since 1892. C.J. Coon started what was then known as Camp Franklin, a hunting and fishing lodge. It offers great lake views and classic Northwoods cabins! (We are invited for lunch so please let me know if you are interested!)

July 7 Koller Park / MW Dam

Located in downtown Manitowish Waters. There are great views of Rest Lake as well as the Dam. We may want to bring a still-life set up (Picnic style) to provide an interesting painting opportunity! Parking and bathhouse are available. Lunch at the Pea Patch.

July 14 Manito Art League Show

We will not be painting this day as many of the local artists are involved in the show. Please stop in at the Manitowish Community Center to enjoy the show! (Show runs July 14-17)

July 21 ...Winkler's Northern Exposure Greenhouse

A beautiful garden center which specializes in preplanted containers for the artistic gardener - including unique glazed pottery, moss lined vine baskets and antique pieces. 5421 Park St. in Boulder. (On Hwy M next to the Guide's Inn)

July 28 Star Lake

The Sayner-Star Lake area is located between Eagle River and Minocqua and north of St. Germain (Hwy 70) on Hwy 155. Star Lake is located on County N East North to County K West. Interesting sites include the Miltown Depot, Old Bait Shop and the Vilas Historical Museum. Lunch at the Sayner Pub on Main St.

August 4 Black Bear Bar

Truly rustic, clean, cozy family orientated bar and grill with daily specials. Outside dining and a playground along Shishebogama Creek. Located on Hwy 70 West about 5 miles west of Hwy 51. 11045 State Hwy 70 W. Plan to stay for lunch!

August 11 Dixie's Coffee Shop**

New in Manitowish Waters, Dixie's is a beautiful little spot overlooking Vance Lake. Prepare to start your painting day early with delicious coffee and sweets from the Shop!! Located at 6085 County Hwy W, across from Dietz's gas station.

August 18 Big Bear Hideaway-Boulder

On the west edge of Boulder Junction, beneath a canopy of towering pines, stands the unique Big Bear Hideaway. Crafted with native logs and stone, 10482 W. Main St. Boulder

August 25 Camp Jorn

A Jewel in the Northwoods of Wisconsin, Camp Jorn YMCA is situated on the shores of pristine Rest Lake in Manitowish Waters. 13591 Zenner Lane off of Red Feather Rd.
