We meet **Thursdays at 8:30 til noon** for painting or drawing in any media. Participation is **FREE** and open to summer vacationers as well as the local artists. Our only rule is to respect each other, the locations that we visit and the hosts that invite us. Beginners to professionals are welcome.

Hints for the Outdoor Artists:

- ☆ **Art materials**—Bring everything you will need to complete your artwork. (i.e. pencil & sketch pad, paint & canvas, pastels & paper, etc) Don't forget paper towel!
- ☆ **Garbage collection bag**—we want to be sure to leave our work area as clean as when we arrived.
- ☆ **Sun Protection**—Sunscreen / long sleeved shirt / hat / water / umbrella. As the sun moves you may need to be protected. You may also want to protect your palette from the sun interfering with your color selection.
- ☆ **Bug Spray** – Don't wear perfume or cologne, as it attracts bugs. **Bring your bug spray**—This is the Northwoods!!
- ☆ **Camera** – Sometimes a great scene provides an opportunity to take pictures that can be used in the future to complete what was started 'plein air' or to do a new studio piece using the original outdoor piece as a source / study.
- ☆ **Clothes**—Wear dull colors to reduce reflection onto the painting or palette. Dress in layers to accommodate any change in weather.

June 6 Boulder Boat Landing (H&K)

Located outside of Boulder Junction, this is a nice little spot with lake vistas and river rapids flowage. Parking and Latrine available. Lunch in Boulder.

June 13 Clearwater Camp

Clearwater Camp is located in Minocqua and situated on Tomahawk Lake. Clearwater Camp's 67 acres include a five-acre island, connected to the mainland by a picturesque footbridge. Since 1933, Clearwater Camp has been providing a traditional, sleepaway adventure camp for young women. Many of the green-and-white painted mainland buildings or outlying brown camper cabins have stood the test of time. Clearwater's features include a hilltop dining room, a lakeside gathering hall, an overwater boathouse, tennis courts, a riding stable and riding ring. Great Plein Air opportunities! Located at 7490 E. Clearwater Road.

June 20 Coon's Franklin Lodge

Located 10 miles north of Minocqua in Arbor Vitae. This beautiful lodge has been owned and operated by the Coon Family since 1892. It offers great lake views and classic Northwoods cabins! (We are invited to stay for lunch so please let me know if you are interested!)

June 27 Hawk's Nest

Canoe Outfitters that handle Canoe Trips, Outfitting, and Adventure Trips on the Wisconsin River, the Turtle Flambeau Flowage, the Manitowish River. Located on Hwy 51 between Manitowish Waters and Mercer. Fun vistas for painting! The address is 263 Hwy 51 North.

July 11 Cedaroma Lodge

Located on Little St. Germain lake, it is a classic Northwoods resort with 11 cabins of various sizes and a beautiful waterfront. The address is 1011 Cedaroma Drive which just past downtown St. Germain on Highway 70 East.

August 8 Star Lake

The Sayner-Star Lake area is located between Eagle River and Minocqua and north of St. Germain (Hwy 70) on Hwy 155. Star Lake is located on County N, south of County K. Interesting sites include the Miltown Depot, Old Bait Shop and the Vilas Historical Museum. Lunch at the Sayner Pub on Main St.

August 15 Red Pine Camp for Girls

Red Pine Camp was founded in 1937. The Camp is located at 8531 Red Pine Road in Woodruff. The Camp has beautiful frontage on the shore of Clear Lake. They have 16 red sided cabins located among the amazing greens of the trees. Should be fun to paint!

August 22 Black Bear Bar

Classic, clean and cozy family-oriented bar and grill with delicious daily specials. Outside dining and beautiful wild flower frontage along Shishebogama Creek. Located on Hwy 70 West about 5 miles west of Hwy 51. (11045 State Hwy 70 W.) Plan to stay for lunch!

The Brewery, Torpy Park, and Main Street all provide very interesting opportunities. This is a great place to finish our painting season followed by lunch at the Brewery. Parking is available in Lot C, next to the post office.
